After the great flood, Noah's son Shem had children, and so did their children. Many, many generations later, a man named Abraham was born. God made Abraham a beautiful promise:

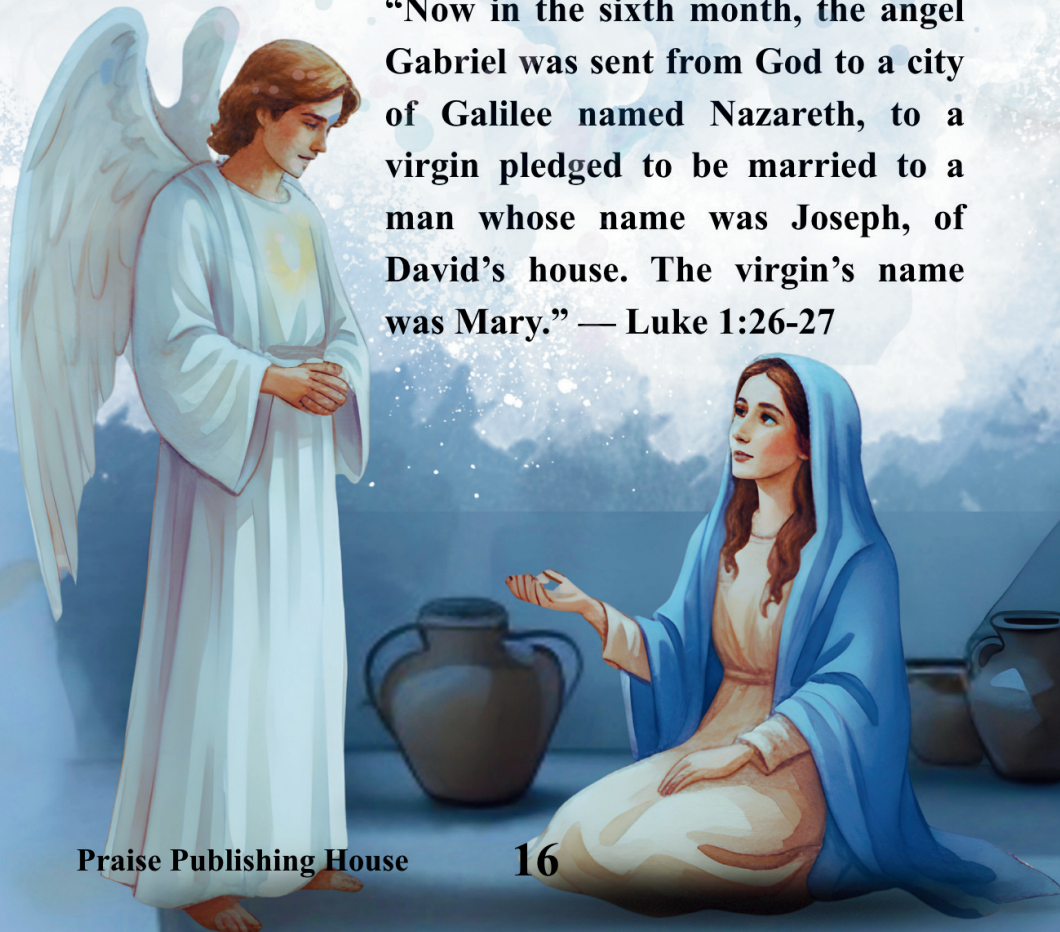
**“Through your family, all the nations of the earth will be blessed.” (Genesis 22:18)**

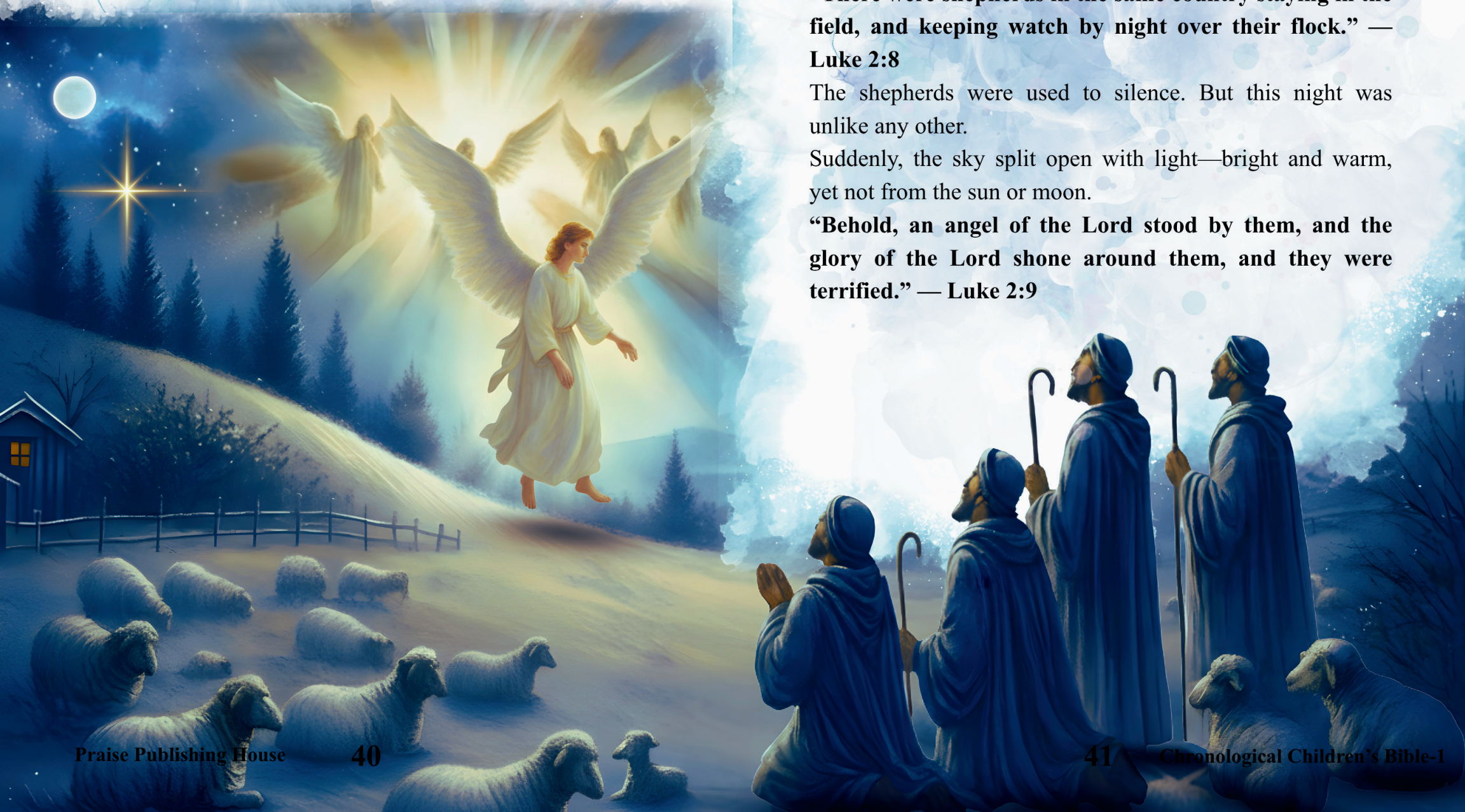
**“There were shepherds in the same country staying in the field, and keeping watch by night over their flock.” —**
